Young Man's Death Was Not Suspicious

Police last night ruled out any suspicious circumstances surrounding the death of a young man whose body was found on the north foreshore in Belfast yesterday.

A spokesman said that the body was that of a 19-year-old from the Belfast area, ending initial speculation that it might be that of 21-year-old Martin Kelly, a plumber and part-time barman from Holywood who has been missing since New Year's Day.



Officers searching for Mr Kelly found the man's body at a tip in DarganCrescent on the Harbour Estate. The investigation was triggered by a tip-off telephone call.

The discovery followed the disappearance of Mr Kelly who was last seenleaving Pat's Bar on Garmoyle Street in Belfast's docks area - close to where the body was found.

He had gone to the bar with friends, but had stayed on after they leftand was seen later leaving alone.
