PSNI make Martin Kelly appeal

Detectives want to trace a woman who may have exchanged her phone number with a County Down man who has been missing since New Year's Day.

Martin Kelly, 21, was last seen leaving Pat`s Bar in the Dock`s area of Belfast after he had been out with friends.

The previous evening, New Year`s Eve, he is believed to have spoken to a woman in the Priory Inn, Holywood, where he worked as a part-time barman.



The PSNI said the couple may have swapped phone numbers.

Officers also wish to speak to a middle-aged couple who were drinking with an elderly woman in Pat`s Bar on New Year`s Day.

A police spokesman said: "Despite extensive inquiries detectives have been unable to identify any of these people."

Mr Kelly, a plumber from Holywood, stayed on in the south Belfast bar after his friends left and was seen leaving it alone shortly after 7pm on January 1.
